This wine has a brilliant and clean purplish red hue, with dark legs and cathedering showing its glyceric content. With glass in place, there is a noticeable raspberry aroma and the taster immediately becomes aware of the American oak vanilla that appears in perfect harmony with the fruit, without any doubt it belongs to a new barrel.

On the palate, the wine is powerful, tannic and meaty, with a slight acidic touch. Besides, its happiness and liveliness denotes a long life.

An intense and lingering bouquet, the French oak toast predominates over the slight aromas of spices that are provided by the Hungarian oak.

The blending of aromas and tastes, together with its texture, make this wine a conundrum of complex sensations in symphony with each other.

This wine is produced on 100% Mencia grape and has aged 6 months in French, Hungarian and American oak barrels.

Brilliant and clean in appearance. Intense ruby red colour with young purple hues. In the nose appropriate intensity, complex and in good evolution, wide conjunction of fruity and vegetable shades, rounded and an excellent lingering finish.

On the palate, dry with a very good intensity. Meaty, excellent tannic expression. Rich, tasty and complex. Long and round aftertaste.
